North Tahoe Forest The Truckee Management Program (TNTFMP) is a pilot program bringing resources to landowners to private plan and implement critical wildfire resilience and health projects their on properties. To be eligible to apply for funding, landowners must own greater than 3 acres and less than 5000 acres of private, non-industrial forestland.

TNTFMP provides technical assistance or funding for various types of work including developing a management plan, CEQA preparation, tree and brush thinning, tree release, pruning, site preparation, tree planting, and work to support tree growth.
