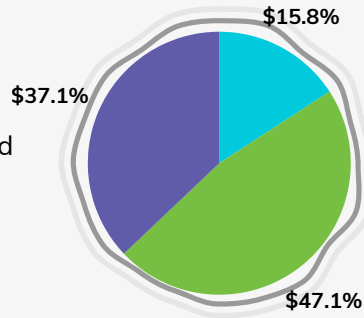

- Creating readiness for structured funds to support localized solutions that will help Tahoe communities process woody biomass, transition to locally-produced energy, and provide interconnected solutions for people and places.
- Stimulating entrepreneurial activity in the forest through regional and state-wide partnerships to grow a forest economy, create jobs, and grow a workforce.
- “The Majestic Ally-Oop” - Realizing a vision to utilize Tahoe’s trees to locally wood and develop fire-resistant building materials to address our housing crisis.
- Designing localized solutions scaled for the Tahoe region by structuring catalytic grants and regenerative investments to advance scalable forest solutions.

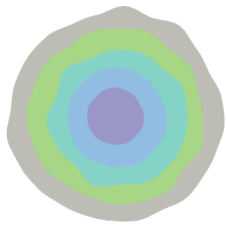
